PROJECT NAME: REFURBISHMENT OF BULK AND INTERNAL WATER RETICULATION TO NOLUKHANYO (BATHURST) – PHASE 1B

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified, experienced and skilled contractors for the construction of the following:

Only Tenderers with a Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) minimum grading as indicated above will be eligible to tender.

The project scope includes the following:

- Equipping new Mansfield pumpstation;
- Equipping new Port Alfred pumpstation;
- Installing Telemetry system;
- Installing 2x163 kℓ galvanized steel tanks; and
- Manufacture and install reservoir pipework (inlet, outlet, overflow and scour).

Tender documents may be collected from **Ndlambe Local Municipality offices**, Port Alfred Civic Centre Causeway, from **Monday, 12 February 2018 until Thursday, 15 February 2018** (Office hours 08h00 until 16h00). A non-refundable cash deposit of **R800.00** for each document is required. Bid Documents will only be issued on a receipt obtained from the cashier's office at Ndlambe Local Municipality.

A **compulsory** Tender Clarification Meeting will be held. Details of the meeting are:

Prospective tenderers who arrive more than 5 minutes late will not be allowed to attend the abovementioned meeting.

Completed tender documents in sealed envelopes must be placed in the tender box at Port Alfred Civic Centre Causeway, Port Alfred by no later than 12:00 on Wednesday, 28 February 2018 where the tenders will be opened in public.

BIDDERS SHALL TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Prices must be valid for at least five months (150) days from the closing date (**confirmation hereof to be stated on quotation**).
2. Prices quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT.
3. Ndlambe Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
4. Bids that are late will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only quotation will not necessarily be accepted. Quotations per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
5. An original tax clearance certificate issued by SARS must accompany all quotations OR a tax reference number and PIN or TCC number must be provided.
6. The following forms are required to be completed and submitted together with the bid:
 - Declaration of Interest form (**MBD4**).
 - Certificate of Independent Bid Determination (**MBD9**).
 - Bidders who wish to claim for preferential points in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, must also submit a completed form **MBD 6.1** as well as a **certified copy** of the proof of B-BBEE status level of contribution (Certificate or Affidavit).

7. It should be noted that, in respect of this bid, the 80/20 points system will be applied, 80 being for price and 20 for the B-BBEE status level.
8. The award will be made in terms of the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.
9. Bidders must submit Company Registration Certificate and Company Profile.
10. A Municipal Billing Clearance Certificate, which covers, if applicable, both the company and its directors, must accompany all bids.
11. Evidence of registration of company on the Central Supplier Database must be provided (CSD "MAAA" number).
