Local SMMEs are required to be appointed through this project as domestic subcontractor(s) by the appointed Principal Contractor to complete portions of the Works as indicated in the tender document. The number of SMMEs to be appointed for the abovementioned work is up to the discretion of the appointed Principal Contractor but will not be less than 30% of the civil work only (Excluding mechanical, electrical and RO plant related work). Only local SMMEs that attended the compulsory Clarification Meeting will be eligible for consideration.

This project intends to promote the following in the execution of the Works:

- Labour intensive construction methods using local unemployed men and women; and
- Training and transfer of skills.

Tender documents may be collected from **Ndlambe Local Municipality offices**, Port Alfred Civic Centre Causeway or 44 Campbell Street, Port Alfred, 6170, from **Tuesday, 03 April 2018 until Thursday, 05 April 2018** (Office hours 08h00 until 16h00). A non-refundable cash deposit of **R800.00** for each document is required. Bid Documents will only be issued on a receipt obtained from the cashier's office at Ndlambe Local Municipality.

A **compulsory** Tender Clarification Meeting will be held. Details of the meeting are:

Prospective tenderers and local SMME representatives who arrive more than 5 minutes late will not be allowed to attend the abovementioned meeting.

Completed tender documents in sealed envelopes must be placed in the tender box at Alexandria Municipal offices, 01 Otto du Plessis Street by no later than 12:00 on Wednesday, 02 May 2018 where the tenders will be opened in public.

BIDDERS SHALL TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. Prices must be valid for at least five months (150) days from the closing date (confirmation hereof to be stated on quotation).
2. Prices quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT.
3. Ndlambe Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of the bid.
4. Bids that are late will not be considered, whilst the lowest or only quotation will not necessarily be accepted. Quotations per fax or E-mail will also not be considered.
5. An original tax clearance certificate issued by SARS must accompany all quotations OR a tax reference number and PIN or TCC number must be provided.
6. The following forms are required to be completed and submitted together with the bid:
 - Declaration of Interest form (**MBD4**).
 - Certificate of Independent Bid Determination (**MBD9**).
 - Bidders who wish to claim for preferential points in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, must also submit a completed form **MBD 6.1** as well as a **certified copy** of the proof of B-BBEE status level of contribution (Certificate or Affidavit).

7. It should be noted that, in respect of this bid, the 80/20 points system will be applied, 80 being for price and 20 for the B-BBEE status level.
8. The award will be made in terms of the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.
9. Bidders must submit Company Registration Certificate and Company Profile.
10. A Municipal Billing Clearance Certificate, which covers, if applicable, both the company and its directors, must accompany all bids.
11. Evidence of registration of company on the Central Supplier Database must be provided (CSD "MAAA" number).
