Service Providers are hereby invited to submit quotations for the Supply and delivery of Water Treatment Chemicals for the Bathurst and Alexandria Water Treatment Plants.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. 10 x 240kg Hypochlorite to Alexandria
2. 10 x 240kg Hypochlorite to Bathurst
3. 2 x 240kg UltraFloc to Bathurst

Bidders Shall Take Note of the Following Bid Conditions:

1. The Prices must be valid for at least ninety (90) days from the closing date.
2. The Prices quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT and delivery.
3. Ndlambe Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserve the right to accept the whole part of the bid.
4. A tax clearance certificate issued by SARS must accompany all quotations OR a tax reference number and PIN or TCC number must be provided.
5. Bidders must complete Council's Declaration of Interest form (**MBD4**).
6. Bidders must complete Certificate of Independent Bid Determination (**MBD9**).
7. Bidders who wish to claim for preferential points in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, must submit a completed form **MBD 6.1** as well as a **certified copy** of the proof of B-BBEE status level of contribution.
8. A Municipal Billing Clearance Certificate must accompany all bids (in the event of a bidder being a company, also in respect of any of its directors).
9. Evidence of registration of company on the Central Supplier Database (CSD) must be provided (Supplier Number).

It should be noted that the 80/20 points system will be applied, 80 being for price and 20 for the B-BBEE status level as defined in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.
