SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE UPDATE

PORT ALFRED CBD

We are pleased to inform you that the scheduled maintenance to install the 200mm diameter valve on Main Street was successfully completed. This installation is the first step in a series of critical upgrades, as we work towards replacing the aging Asbestos Cement (AC) pipework in the Port Alfred CBD.

The valve installation should have a significant impact as in the past, the old 200mm AC pipe in Main Street was prone to frequent bursts. This forced us to "choke" the flow from the Port Alfred Water Treatment Works, reducing water pressure and supply to the community. Now, with the new valve in place, we are able to restore full flow and pressure to both the West Bank and East Bank areas.

We are optimistic that this improvement will resolve the issue of low flow to no flow during the pumping process to both the East Reservoir and West Reservoirs thereby providing a more reliable water supply for residents.

We thank you for your patience and cooperation during the installation, and we look forward to continuing to enhance the water infrastructure in your area.
